Aspire GED Prep: In partnership with the Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C) Aspire GED Program, classes are offered at the PNC Fairfax Connection in all sections of the GED, as well as basic math, literacy and writing. Prepare for the current GED test, as well as the online format. The program helps students strengthen their academic skills and build confidence so that they can achieve their educational and career goals. Registration is required by calling the Cuyahoga Community College Metro Campus at 216-987-3029 or the Cleveland Heights Office at 216-371-7138.

Basic Computer Skills: Basic instruction on the center's Macs. Learn software programs to access the internet, manage files and create documents.
